## Greetings PAOG Family,

I pray that you are encouraged in the Lord! I'd like to share a verse that's inspiring me, "For you are my hiding place; you protect me from trouble. You surround me songs of victory." (Psalm 32:7, NLT) I praise God for His keeping power!

I sincerely thank you for your patience and understanding during this very unique time. As I've stated previously, my aim has been to lead with wisdom, compassion, awareness, and a proactive disposition. I will continue to do so.

With respect to our Bounce Back Plan, I'd like to share a couple updates:

- 1. The City of Milwaukee Health Department has recently indicated that local gathering restrictions for religious organizations will be lightened. The number of congregants permissible is now 250 or 25% of the total occupancy limit.
- 2. PAOG will gradually resume gathering onsite to meet the allowable number per local guidelines:
  - a. February 21st and February 28th:
    - i. 100 members and guests
    - ii. Online viewing continued via Facebook Live.
    - iii. Online corporate prayer will continue on Wednesday nights from 6 p.m.-7 p.m.

## b. March-May:

- **i.** 150-175 people (25%)
- ii. Online viewing continued via Facebook Live.
- iii. Online corporate prayer will continue on Wednesday nights from 6 p.m.-7 p.m.

## 3. Guidelines for Onsite Attendance

- a. Return to the church free of COVID-19 symptoms. Self-quarantine if you've recently been in large crowds or knowingly have been in contact with someone with COVID symptoms. Call the church to have a member of the altar care team or a leader reach out to you with love and prayer.
- b. Register through Eventbrite.
- c. Participate in temperature/health screening upon building entry.
- d. Wear a mask.



- e. Follow seating directions of the ushers.
- f. Observe six feet of physical/social distancing.
- g. Wear a wristband visibly and respect the interaction levels of each person.
- h. Comply with all signage and markings posted throughout the building, including restrooms.
- i. Exit immediately after service and only socialize on the parking lot if desired.

## **COVID-19 Vaccine**

The COVID-19 vaccine is a hot international topic. I realize that many people have questions and concerns. I'm aware that some members have already been vaccinated and others have plans to do so. I'm also aware that some members have reservations and therefore have no immediate plans for vaccination.

At this time, I <u>do not</u> endorse vaccination, nor do I condemn those who choose vaccination. It's a decision that individuals must make for themselves and their families. It's a decision that should be made prayerfully, thoughtfully, and with sound information.
